Chapter – I : General

- 1.1 The Rajasthan Electricity Regulatory Commission (RERC) has been functioning since January, 2000. During the year FY 2012-13, Shri D.C. Samant was its Chairman and Sh. S.K. Mittal & Sh. S. Dhawan were Member (Finance) and Member (Technical), respectively.
- 1.2 Sh. Vinod Kapoor, worked as Secretary, RERC upto 1.8.12, whereafter Sh. G.K. Sharma, worked as Secretary, RERC with effect from 2.8.12, till end of the year, under report.

Chapter-III : ARR/Tariff orders issued by the Commission

- 1. Annual Revenue Requirement (ARR) & Revision of Wheeling Charges and Retail Supply Tariff for FY 12-13 of Jaipur, Ajmer and Jodhpur Discoms.**
 - 1.1. The Discoms, filed petitions for determination of ARR & wheeling charges and revision of Retail Supply Tariff U/s 62 and 64 of the Electricity Act, 2003, for the FY 12-13, in the third week of December, 2011.
 - 1.2. The public hearings in the matter were held on 02.5.12 and on 03.5.12, at Jaipur.
 - 1.3. After considering the views of stakeholders, the Commission issued its order in the matter of revision of retail tariff, and determination of ARR of Discoms, for FY 2012-13, on 8.8.2012.

1.4. The Discoms, in their petitions for determination of Annual Revenue Requirement (ARR), and for tariff for FY 2012-13, projected an ARR of Rs. 30,314 crores, and net deficit of Rs. 12714 crores, after receipt of Govt. subsidy at existing tariff, and sought a tariff increase of Rs. 3267 crores. The Commission determined the ARR as Rs. 23,342 crores, with a net deficit of Rs. 6614 crores, for FY 2012-13, at the existing tariff and a tariff increase, which will lead to an overall increase in revenue by Rs. 2,821 crores, for twelve months' period. For the balance period of the year under report, the increase in revenue was assessed as Rs. 1,816 Crores.

1.6. Other important decisions:

- (i) Commission considered the farm house connection at par with domestic category as proposed by Discoms.
- (ii) Commission shifted the category of Radio Stations, Television Stations and their Transmitters from Mixed Load to NDS as proposed by Discoms.
- (iii) Commission covered the wedding houses in NDS category, both for the purpose of tariff, and for release of connection, as proposed by Discoms.
- (iv) Commission covered the public gardens, belonging to the Government/Local bodies, under Mixed load category, as proposed by Discoms.

2. Annual Revenue Requirement (ARR) & Revision of Retail Supply Tariff for FY 13-14 of Jaipur, Ajmer and Jodhpur Discoms.

- 2.1. Discoms filed petitions for ARR & revision of Retail Supply Tariff U/s 62 and 64 of the Electricity Act 2003, for the FY 13-14 on 30.11.12 seeking increase in tariff for supply for Domestic and Non-Domestic category consumers having consumption of more than 500 units per month. Discoms also proposed an increase in tariff of Agriculture category both, in metered and in Flat Rate category.

- 2.2. The Discoms in their petitions for determination of Annual Revenue Requirement (ARR) and for tariff for FY 2013-14, projected an ARR of Rs. 32,596 crores and net deficit of Rs. 11,454 crores, after receipt of Govt. subsidy, at existing tariff and sought a tariff increase of Rs. 2,702 crores.
- 2.3. On scrutiny of petitions, some deficiencies were found and accordingly, preliminary data gaps on the petitions were sent to three Discoms on 7.12.2012. The Commission admitted the petitions on 21.12.12 and directed that a brief summary of the petitions should be published by the Discoms in news papers for inviting comments/suggestions of general public.
- 2.4. Accordingly, Public Notices, with salient features of the petitions, inviting objections/comments/suggestions, from persons, desirous of submitting the same, were published in the newspapers and the petitions were also placed on the website of the Commission and of the Discoms.
- 2.5. Detailed data gaps were sent to Discoms. In response to data gaps JVVNL, AVVNL and JdVVNL submitted their replies on 18.02.13, 21.02.13 and 20.02.13 respectively.
- 2.6. In all, comments/suggestions from 25 persons were received on JVVNL's petition, from 18 persons on AVVNL's petition and from 17 persons on JdVVNL's petition. The Commission forwarded the suggestions/comments submitted by the stakeholders to the respective Discoms for obtaining their reply. Discoms sent their replies to them under intimation to the Commission.
- 2.7. The public hearings were held in the matter on 07.03.2013 and on 08.03.2013 at Jaipur. As on 31.3.13, order was under consideration of the Commission.

3. Trueing up of ARR of Discoms

- 3.1. The Petitions for true up of ARR for FY 08 to FY10 of Ajmer Discoms, true up of ARR for FY 09 and FY 10 for Jaipur and for FY 09 & FY 10 of Jodhpur Discoms, have been admitted by the Commission and Commission directed that a brief summary of the petitions should be published by the Discoms in news papers for inviting comments/suggestions of general public.
- 3.2. Public Notices, with salient features of the petitions, inviting objections/comments/suggestions, from persons, desirous of submitting the same, were published in the newspapers and the petitions were also placed on the website of the Commission and of the Discoms.
- 3.3. Final hearing in the matters was held on 20.12.2012. As on 31.3.2013 order was under consideration of the Commission.

4. Determination of Wheeling Charges and Losses for FY 2013-14 for JVVNL, AVVNL and JdVVNL.

- 4.1. Discoms, collectively filed a joint petition for determination of Wheeling Charges and Losses for FY 2013-14 U/s 42(2) & 86 of the Electricity Act 2003 for the FY 2013-14 on 16.01.2013. The Commission admitted the petitions on 21.01.2013 and directed that a brief summary of the petitions should be published by the Discoms in news papers for inviting comments/suggestions of general public.
- 4.2. Accordingly, Public Notices, with salient features of the petitions, inviting objections/comments/suggestions, from persons, desirous of submitting the same, were published in the newspapers and the petitions were also placed on the website of the Commission and of the Discoms. The Commission forwarded the suggestions/comments submitted by the stakeholders to the respective Discoms for obtaining their reply. As on 31st March, 2013, reply from Discoms was awaited.

5. Petition for introduction of Time of Day (ToD) Tariff for HT industry (Large and Medium) Categories in the State of Rajasthan.

- 5.1. Discoms, filed a joint petition for introduction of Time of Day (ToD) Tariff for HT industry (Large and Medium) Categories in Rajasthan on 29.02.12.
- 5.2. Commission admitted the petition and directed that a brief summary of the petitions be published by the Discoms in news papers for inviting comments/suggestions of general public.
- 5.3. Commission forwarded the objections/comments/suggestions submitted by the stakeholders to petitioners for reply. Petitioners sent their replies to the stakeholders under intimation to the Commission.
- 5.4. The public hearings were held in the matter on 02.5.12 and on 03.5.12 at Jaipur, along with hearing on tariff petitions.
- 5.5. The Commission analysed the petitions of Discoms and observed that no clear relationship between peak hours proposed by Discoms and median load curve based on consumption can be established whereas off-peak hours show coincidence with proposed off-peak hours only during three months (December, January and February) out of twelve months and Discom did not furnish unrestricted load curve showing cuts imposed during various periods and clearly bringing out the peaks and valleys in the system by superimposing load shedding/power cuts imposed by them.

- 5.6. The Commission also noted that higher power purchase cost, during peak hours alone, cannot be a reasonable ground for higher tariff during peak hours, unless it is established that licensees are required to buy additional short term power during the proposed peak hours and the quantum of such purchase and additional cost thereof, justifies the said higher tariff during peak hours. No such analysis and justification was furnished by the petitioners.
- 5.7. In the light of the position discussed above, the Commission did not accept the proposal of Discoms for levy of ToD tariff and accordingly, disposed of the petition, vide its order dt. 8.11.12

6. Tariff for sale of electricity from Wind Power Plants in the State to distribution licensees

The tariff for wind power plants getting commissioned in FY 2012-13, was determined, vide Commission order dated 07.09.2012, as under :

The loss on account of truing up of transmission function, was arrived at Rs 6.37 cr. for FY 09-10 which was being passed on in ARR of FY 12-13. After truing up of SLDC function for FY 09-10, there was a gain of Rs.2.42 crores which was deducted from the ARR of FY 12-13. There was no impact on account of truing up of partnership projects.

The surplus on account of truing up of Transmission Function for FY 10-11 was Rs.37.97 crores which was adjusted in the ARR of FY 12-13. After truing up for FY 10-11, the surplus for SLDC function was Rs 8.94 Cr., which was adjusted in the ARR of FY 12-13. There was no impact on account of truing up of partnership projects.

13. In the matter of review petition regarding Commission's order dated 27.4.2011 for truing up of power stations of RVUN for the year 2004-05 to 2008-09.

Vide Commission order dated 10.05.2012, the amount recoverable from respective distribution companies by RVUN as a result of truing up for the year 2004-05 to 2008-09 was 49.4818 crores, which had been recovered from respective Distribution Companies, in proportion to sale of Electricity to them during this period. Commission approved that RVUN should utilize this amount against 400 crores included by them in the Annual Accounts of FY 08-09 towards liabilities for terminal benefits against which only 40 crores was allowed by the Commission in truing up order dated 27.4.2011.

14. In principle approval of additional Capital Works to be undertaken during FY 2011-12 and beyond, in Suratgarh Super Thermal Power Station (SSTPS) of Rajasthan Raja Vidyut Utpadan Nigam Ltd., (RVUN).

Chapter-IV : Other Orders, issued by the Commission

1. Amendment in Supply Code Regulations, 2004

1.1. Discoms collectively filed a joint petition (334/12) on 25.06.12, seeking amendment in RERC (Electricity Supply Code & Connected Matters) Regulations, 2004. Discoms also submitted a supplementary petition, seeking some other amendments in Supply Code Regulations on 24.9.12. The matter was heard on 19.10.12 and Commission sought some clarifications on the petition. The same was awaited, as on 31.03.13.

2. Determination of pooled cost of power purchase for FY 2012-13 of Jaipur, Ajmer and Jodhpur Discoms.

- 2.1. Discoms, filed petitions for determination of pooled cost of power purchase for FY 2012-13 on 31.1.12. Commission vide its letter dt. 24.08.12 directed Discoms that a brief summary of the petitions be published in news papers for inviting comments/objections from general public.
- 2.2. Commission heard the matter on 12.12.12 & vide its order dt. 11.1.2013, provisionally determined the pooled power purchase cost, as Rs. 2.75/unit for all three Discoms, which is 5% lower than the weighted average pooled cost of power purchase, indicated by the three Discoms, in the petitions. The provisional pooled cost of power, determined vide this order, became applicable, with effect from 1.1.2013.

3. Petitions for Approval of Investment Plan of Discoms for FY 2012-13

- 3.1. Discoms, filed petitions for approval of investment plan for the FY 12-13 on 31.1.12.
- 3.2. Commission admitted the petitions and directed that a brief summary of the petitions be published by the Discoms in news papers, for inviting comments/suggestions of general public.
- 3.3. Commission forwarded the suggestions/comments submitted by the stakeholders to the respective Discoms for obtaining their reply and Discoms submitted their replies by 2nd week of June, 2012.
- 3.4. The matter was heard on 19.06.2012 and Commission vide its order dt. 30.11.12, approved the investment plan in respect of different distribution companies as under:

5. Issue of cost of burnt meter:

- 5.1. Sh. Magan Singh Naruka, as an individual, filed a petition on 27.12.2011 under Sections 129 (1) and 142 of Electricity Act, 2003 in the matter of contravention of Rules, Regulations and provisions of Electricity Act, 2003, by way of charging of higher meter cost.
- 5.2. The Discoms submitted reply to the notices on 02.4.2012. The matter was heard on 03.4.12. Commission disposed of the petition, vide its order dt. 17.08.2012 and held that impugned orders issued by the Discoms are in violation of the Act/Regulations and accepted the contention of the petitioner that cost of meter can be recovered only through procedure, prescribed in the Regulations.
