Mittal was Member (Finance) upto 4.9.13 and thereafter, Sh. Vinod Pandya worked as Member (Finance) from 10.3.14 onwards. Sh. S. Dhawan was the Member (Technical) during the year FY 2013-14. Sh. G.K. Sharma, worked as Secretary, RERC upto 31.8.13, and thereafter, with effect from 12.12.13 till end of the year, under report.

An Order was issued by the Commission in the matter of Annual Performance review for FY 2009-10 for KTPS (Unit 1 to 7), STPS (Unit 1 to 6), RGTPP, DCCPP and Mahi hydel power station and the determination of tariff for FY 2010-11 for CTPP (Unit-1), for FY 2011-12 for CTPP (Unit 1&2) & for FY 2012-13 for KTPS (Unit 1 to 7), STPS (Unit 1 to 6), RGTPP, DCCPP, CTPP and Mahi hydel power station on 06.06.2013. Summary of the above Order is as under:

Annual performance (True-up) for FY 2009-10

Commission ordered that an amount of Rs.59.86 cr. towards fixed charges and Rs.146.67 cr. towards variable charges is payable by RVUN to Discoms, as a result of true up. The Commission has not adjusted the fixed and variable charges payable on account of true-up of FY 09-10 in the tariff, of FY 12-13 for the reason that such adjustment would lead to a tariff, different from what is admissible under the Regulations based on normative parameters. Therefore, in order to correctly depict the tariff, admissible as per Regulations the Commission directed that the total payable amount of Rs.206.53 cr. shall be separately paid by RVUN to Discoms in the ratio of energy purchased by them, in six equal monthly instalments.

(10.) Annual Revenue Requirement (ARR) & Revision of Wheeling Charges and Retail Supply Tariff for FY 13-14 of Jaipur, Ajmer and Jodhpur Discoms.

- Discoms filed petitions for ARR & revision of Retail Supply Tariff U/s 62 and 64 of the Electricity Act 2003 for the FY 13-14 on 30.11.12, seeking increase in tariff in various categories including Agriculture.
- The public hearings were held in the matter, on 07.03.2013 and 08.03.2013 at Jaipur. After considering the views of stakeholders, the Commission issued its order in the

matter of revision of retail tariff, and determination of ARR of Discoms for FY 2013-14, on 06.06.2013.

- c. The Discoms, in their petitions for determination of Annual Revenue Requirement (ARR) and tariff for FY 2013-14, projected an ARR of Rs. 32596 Crore and a net deficit of Rs. 11454 Crores, after receipt of Govt. subsidy at existing tariff and sought a tariff increase of Rs. 2702 Crores to meet their deficit. The Commission determined the ARR as Rs. 25247 Crores, with net a deficit of Rs. 3982 Crores, for FY 2013-14, at the existing tariff and a tariff increase, which will lead to an overall increase in revenue by Rs. 2676

(11.) Other important decisions:

- (i) 'Moksh dhams,' cemeteries and grave yards shall be covered under Domestic category.
- (ii) LT - Non Domestic Consumer and LT Bulk supply for mixed load consumer, having aggregate sanctioned connected load above 18.65 KW (25 HP),

- may opt for billing on the basis of demand and in that case, fixed charges as applicable for NDS/HT-2 & ML/HT-4 category shall apply respectively.
- (iii) Metro Rail will be categorized under Large Industrial Category (HT-5). The term "Railway Traction Load" appearing under applicability of Large Industrial Service, shall be read as "Metro and Railway Traction Load".
 - (iv) A rebate of 10% will be given on energy charges on energy consumed by Metro Rail services in Rajasthan for a period of 5 Years, from the date of electrification, after which normal tariff shall be charged."

(12.) True up of ARR of Discoms for FY 08 to FY 10

The Petitions for true up of ARR for FY 08 to FY10 of Ajmer Discoms, true up of ARR for FY 09 for Jaipur and for FY 09 & FY 10 of Jodhpur Discoms, were admitted by the Commission and Commission directed that a brief summary of the petitions be published by the Discoms in news papers, for inviting comments/suggestions of general public. After considering the views of stakeholders, the Commission issued its order in the matter of True-up of ARR of Discoms on 04.12.2013.

(13.) Determination of Wheeling Charges and Losses for FY 2013-14 for JVVNL, AVVNL and JdVVNL.

- a. The Discoms, collectively filed a joint petition for determination of Wheeling Charges and Losses for FY 2013-14 U/S 42(2) & 86 of the Electricity Act 2003 for the FY 2013-14, on 16.01.2013. The Commission admitted the petitions on 21.01.2013 and directed that a brief summary of the petitions be published by the Discoms in news papers for inviting comments/suggestions of general public.
- b. Accordingly, Public Notices, with salient features of the petitions, inviting objections/comments/suggestions from persons, desirous of submitting the same, were published in the newspapers and the petitions were also placed on the website of the Commission and of the Discoms. The Commission forwarded the suggestions/comments submitted by the stakeholders to the respective Discom for obtaining the reply.
- c. The public hearing was held in the matter on 02.05.2013 at Jaipur. Commission, vide its order dt. 18.09.2013 disposed of the petition and decided that the data furnished by Discoms were not backed up by any concrete study or facts and were on assumption basis, with one set of assumed data i.e. energy input was used to reallocate the other set of extrapolated figures, calculated on the basis of assumed cost at different voltage levels, to arrive at wheeling charges.

Commission directed that the wheeling charges and losses being charged at that time shall continue to be charged for FY 2013-14.

(14.) Truing up of ARR of Discoms for FY 2010-11 & 11-12.

- a. The Petitions for true up of ARR for FY 2010-11 & 2011-12 of Jaipur, Ajmer & Jodhpur Discoms were filed by Discoms.
- b. Petitions were admitted by the Commission and Commission directed that a brief summary of the petitions be published by the Discoms in news papers, for inviting comments/suggestions of general public.
- c. The Commission forwarded the suggestions/comments submitted by the stakeholders to the respective Discom, for obtaining the replies. As on 31.3.14, replies from Discoms were awaited.

Chapter-IV : Other Orders, issued by the Commission

(1) Investment Plan for Rajasthan Rajya Vidyut Prasaran Nigam Ltd for FY 2013-14.

Commission reduced the envisaged transmission investment plan by 15% and restrict that upto Rs. 2150 Cr. This approval did not include Rs 20 Crore, sought for generation (shared generating projects).The overall investment plan, was as under:-

(2) Petitioner, RVPN, filed petition for seeking directions in the matter of allocation and apportionment of losses of pooled power of M/s Dahanu Solar Power Ltd., M/s Rajasthan Sun Technique Energy Pvt. Ltd and M/s Reliance Green Power Pvt. Ltd. to be injected at 220 KV GSS, Dechu. The Commission, vide order dated 3.10.2013, found that Petition was not fit for admission and disposed that off, accordingly.

(3) Petitioner, M/s RREC, filed petition for determination of generic tariff for purchase of electricity, by distribution licensee from bio-gas based power plants. The Commission vide order dated 31.5.2013, observed that in

absence of Regulations, specifying norms for Biogas plants, it would be appropriate to consider specifying norms through Regulations, instead of determining tariff through an order based on norms adopted by the Commission. Accordingly, the Commission did not to accept the proposal, as due consideration would be accorded, while finalizing the next MYT Regulations for RE technologies to be made effective from FY 14-15.

(4) In the matter of Review of Order dated 10.05.12 in Petition No. RERC/273/11 regarding in principle approval of capital works as additional capitalization for (1240 MW) Coal based Kota Super Thermal Power Station (KSTPS–Stage-I to V, Unit-1 to 7) of Rajasthan Rajya Vidyut Utpadan Nigam Ltd., ('RVUN'). (Petition No.: 330/12)

Commission, vide its order dt 10.05.2012, issued, in the matter of 'in principle' approval of expenditure, on capital works at KSTPS (1240 MW), approved Rs 37595 Lacs for additional capitalization for KSTPS against the works of Rs 45451 Lacs proposed by RVUN.

Aggrieved by the above Order, RVUN filed review petition, seeking review of the order, on the following issues, namely:

(a) Construction of Road Over Bridge (ROB) at LC-15; and

(b) Purchase of Dynamic Coal Balancing system.

After considering petitioner's submissions and stakeholders' comments, Commission, vide its order dt. 22.4.13 approved the capitalization for the expenditure of Rs. 3008 lacs (including IDC), as RVUN's share for the construction of RoB.

(5) Petitions for Approval of Investment Plan of JVVNL, AVVNL & JdVVNL for FY 2013-14.

- a. JVVNL, AVVNL and JdVVNL filed the petitions for approval of investment plan for FY 2013-14 on 21.02.13, 10.04.13, 17.04.13, respectively. Further, JVVNL and AVVNL also filed the revised petitions on 31.05.13 and 04.07.13 respectively.
- b. Commission admitted the petitions and directed that a brief summary of the petitions be published by the Discoms, in news papers, for inviting comments/suggestions of general public.
- c. Commission forwarded the suggestions/comments submitted by the stakeholders to the respective, Discoms, for obtaining their reply. Replies to data gaps and stakeholders comments were submitted till the end of November, 2013, and AVVNL while submitting the same, again revised the figures of investment plan, from 739.34 crores to 1034 crores.

- d. Commission, vide its order dt. 12.02.2014 disposed of said petitions, with the direction that the investment made in FY 13-14 would be examined by the Commission, during Truing up for allowing capitalization, in respect of investment made in the year.

(6) Determination of pooled cost of power-purchase, for FY 2011-12, of Jodhpur Discom.

- a) Jodhpur Vidyut Vitran Nigam Ltd.(JdVVNL) filed a petition for determination of final pooled cost of power- purchase, for FY 2011-12.
- b) Commission admitted the petitions and directed that a brief summary of the petitions be published by the Discoms in news papers, for inviting comments/suggestions of general public.
- c) The matter was heard on 03.12.2013. Commission vide its order dt. 10.12.2013, decided the final pooled cost for FY 2011- 12, as Rs. 2.7350, on the basis of the proposal.

(7) Determination of pooled cost of power purchase for FY 2013-14, of Jodhpur Discom.

- a. Jodhpur Vidyut Vitran Nigam Ltd.(JdVVNL) filed a petition on 08.10.2013, for determination of final pooled cost of power purchase for FY 2013-14. Further, JdVVNL on 01.11.2013, filed a revised petition for determination of provisional pooled cost of power purchase for FY 2013-14, submitting, that earlier the audited accounts for the FY 2012-13 were not finalized.
- b. The hearing in the matter was held on 03.12.2013. Commission, vide its order dt. 12.02.2014, observed that since the audited accounts for FY 2012-13 were finalized, the filed petition for determination of provisional pooled cost had lost relevance, as, on the basis of audited accounts, the final pooled cost of power purchase for 2013-14 can be determined. Accordingly, the Commission directed JdVVNL to file a fresh petition for determination of final pooled cost of power purchase for 2013-14, based on audited accounts of 2012-13.

(8) Determination of pooled cost of power purchase for FY 2013-14 of Jaipur and Ajmer Discom.

- a) Jaipur Vidyut Vitran Nigam Ltd. (JVVNL) and Ajmer Vidyut Vitran Nigam Ltd.(AVVNL) filed a petition for determination of final pooled cost of power purchase for FY 2013-14.

- b) Commission admitted the petitions and directed that a brief summary of the petitions be published by the Discoms in news papers, for inviting comments/suggestions of general public. As on 31.3.2014, the matter was under consideration of the Commission.

Chapter – V : Various Other Activities

1. State Advisory Committee

- 1.1 The State Advisory Committee was re-constituted by the Commission, on 13th January 2014, according to the RERC (State Advisory Committee) Regulations, 2009.
The term of the committee is two years, commencing from 13.01.2014.
- 1.2 During the year, two meetings of the State Advisory Committee were held, on 17th April 2013 & on 22nd February, 2014.

2. Standards of Performance of Discoms

Section 59(2) of the Electricity Act, 2003 stipulates that, the Commission is to publish, at least once a year, the level of performance, achieved by the Distribution Companies. The information of Standards of Performance for the year 2012-13 for Jaipur, Ajmer & Jodhpur Discoms, was placed on the website.

3. Commission Website

The website of the Commission www.erc.rajasthan.gov.in is hosted & maintained by M/s Rajcomp, Jaipur. The website is being updated regularly.

4. Budget & Accounts of the Commission

For the year 2013-14 a budgetary provision of Rs. 1066.17 lacs was approved by the Commission against which an expenditure of Rs. 649.61 lacs was incurred. The Commission received a sum of Rs. 1025.23 lacs during the year 2013-14 towards petition fee etc., and other miscellaneous income, as per the details given below:-
