#### **1. Functions of State Commission.**

As per the Section 86 of the Electricity Act, 2003, the State Electricity Regulatory Commissions are required to discharge the following functions:

- (1) The State Commission shall discharge the following functions, namely:--
  - (a) determine the tariff for generation, supply, transmission and wheeling of electricity, wholesale, bulk or retail, as the case may be, within the State;
  - (b) regulate electricity purchase and procurement process of distribution licensees including the price at which electricity shall be procured from the generating companies or licensees or from other sources through agreements for purchase of power for distribution and supply within the State;
  - (c) facilitate Intra-State transmission and wheeling of electricity;
  - (d) issue licences to persons seeking to act as transmission licensees, distribution licensees and electricity traders with respect to their operations within the State;
  - (e) promote cogeneration and generation of electricity from renewable sources of energy by providing suitable measures for connectivity with the grid and sale of electricity to any person, and also specify, for purchase of electricity from such sources, a percentage of the total consumption of electricity in the area of a distribution licensee;
  - (f) adjudicate upon the disputes between the licensees and generating companies and to refer any dispute for arbitration;
  - (g) levy fee for the purposes of this Act;
  - (h) specify State Grid Code consistent with the Grid Code specified under clause (h) of sub-section (1) of section 79;
  - (i) specify or enforce standards with respect to quality, continuity and reliability of service by licensees;
  - (j) fix the trading margin in the intra-State trading of electricity, if considered necessary; and

- (k) discharge such other functions as may be assigned to it under this Act.
- (2) The State Commission shall advise the State Government on all or any of the following matters, namely:--
- (i) promotion of competition, efficiency and economy in activities of the electricity industry;
  - (ii) promotion of investment in electricity industry;
  - (iii) reorganization and restructuring of electricity industry in the State;
  - (iv) matters concerning generation, transmission, distribution and trading of electricity or any other matter referred to the State Commission by that Government:
- (3) The State Commission shall ensure transparency while exercising its powers and discharging its functions.
- (4) In discharge of its functions, the State Commission shall be guided by the National Electricity Policy, National Electricity Plan and Tariff Policy published under section 3 of the Electricity Act 2003.

## 2. Measures by the Distribution Companies to curb theft of electricity:-

#### **Chapter-VI: ARR/Tariff orders issued by the Commission**

##### **1. Approval of Investment Plan of Rajasthan Rajya Vidyut Prasaran Nigam Limited for FY 2015-16 (Petition No. 488/14)**

Rajasthan Rajya Vidyut Prasaran Nigam Ltd. (RVPN) filed the Petition, under Regulation no. 4 of RERC (Investment Approval) Regulations, 2006 for approval of Investment Plan for FY 2015-16 on 3.12.2014.

The abridged form of the petition was published in the news papers by the petitioner on 11.04.2015 & 12.04.2015. The Commission after considering the submissions of the petitioner and suggestions of the stake holders passed the order on 14th August, 2015. The summary of the Investment Plan for 2015-16 approved by the Commission is as under:

**2. Approval of ARR and determination of tariff for FY 2015-16 for recovery of Transmission and SLDC Charges and True up of ARR for FY 2013-14 of Rajasthan Rajya Vidyut Prasaran Nigam Limited. (Petition No. 499/14)**

RVPN filed Petition for approval of ARR for FY 2015-16 on 31.12.2014 and for recovery of Transmission and SLDC Charges and True-up for FY 2013-14 on 27.03.2015.

The abridged form of the petition was published in the news papers by the petitioner on 11.04.2015 & 12.04.2015. The Commission after considering the submissions of the petitioner and suggestions of the stake holders, passed the order on 14th August, 2015. The summary of the True Up of ARR of FY 2013-14, ARR for Transmission and SLDC function for FY 2015-16 approved by the Commission is as under:

**Note 1:** The tariff at Sr. no. 5 above shall also be applicable for customers availing medium term open access under inter state transactions.

**Note 2:** The State Government vide letter No. F.20 (6) Energy /2010 /Pt.2 dated 13.1.2015 has issued a policy directive to fix the transmission tariff of STU for Solar Power Projects to be commissioned during the period 01.04.2015 to 31.03.2018 or for a capacity of 2000 MW, whichever is earlier, at a rate equal to 50% of normal transmission tariff (Rs. Per MW) as applicable to conventional power for a period of 25 years, for which no subsidy shall be provided by the State Government. The Commission under Section 108 of Electricity Act, 2003 shall be guided by the policy directives issued by the State Government. Therefore Commission directs RVPN to charge the transmission tariff @ equal to 50% of the rate specified at Sr. no. 5 & 6 above for such solar power projects which are covered under the above policy directive.

**3. Determination of Annual Revenue Requirement (ARR) & Retail Supply Tariff of Discoms for FY 2015-16 and approval of true-up of ARR for FY 2013-14 & Investment Plan for FY 2015-16 (Petition no. 552/15, 553/15, 554/15)**

- (i) Discoms filed petitions for determination of ARR for 2015-16 u/s 62 and 64 of the Electricity Act 2003 along with true-up of ARR for FY 2013-14 without giving the proposals of revision of tariff and petitions for approval of Investment Plan for 2015-16 on 15.07.2015. Subsequently, Discoms on 28.08.2015 filed amended petitions removing the deficiencies pointed out vide letter dated 10.08.2015 of the Commission along with the tariff proposals. The petitions were scrutinized and after removal of further deficiencies by the Discoms, the Commission on 4.12.15 permitted the Discoms to publish the notice in newspaper which they got published on 9.12.15. In all 1488 nos. suggestion/comments were received on the petition of the Discoms which were under process.
- (ii) Before a decision could be taken regarding further consideration, an Execution Petition no. 1 of 2016 was filed before the Hon'ble APTEL, which vide order dated 18.02.2016 stayed further proceedings on the tariff petitions filed by Discoms. Discoms were also impleaded as parties to the execution petition. The Hon'ble APTEL, vide its order dt. 04.03.2016, vacated the stay and directed the Commission to take on record the whole data to be filed by the Discoms. Accordingly Discoms on 11.03.2016 filed additional data along with data already submitted by them. Subsequently, Hon'ble APTEL vide its order dt. 17.03.2016 dismissed the execution petition.
- (iii) As on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2016, matter was under consideration of the Commission.

**4. Determination of Additional Surcharge for FY 2014-15 (Petition no. 548/15).**

- (i) Discoms collectively had filed the petition for determination of Additional Surcharge under Section 42 (4) and 39 (2)(d) of the Electricity Act, 2003 (in short the Act) read with regulation 4(2) and 16 of RERC (Terms and Conditions for Open Access) Regulations, in which Additional Surcharge of Rs. 1.39/unit was proposed.
- (ii) Public notices with salient features of the petition, inviting objections/comments/suggestions from persons desirous of submitting the same, were published in the newspapers. The last date for submission of objections/ suggestions was notified as 28.12.2015. In all, 41 persons submitted their objections on the petition.
- (iii) As on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2016, matter was under consideration of the Commission.



**5. Determination of pooled cost of power purchase for FY 14-15 and FY 15-16 of Ajmer Discom (Petition no. 584/15).**

- (i) Ajmer Vidyut Vitran Nigam Ltd.(AVVNL) filed a petition for determination of pooled cost of power purchase for FY 2014-15 and 2015-16 under Regulation 10 (2) (a) of RERC (Renewable Energy Certificate and Renewable Purchase Obligation Compliance Framework) Regulations, 2010 .
- (ii) The matter was heard on 03.03.2016. Considering the data of the Discom and audited accounts placed, Commission vide its order dated 31.03.2016 determined the pooled cost of power purchase for FY 2014-15 and FY 2015-16 as Rs. 3.5565 and Rs. 3.4148 per unit respectively.
- (iii) The pooled cost of power purchase for FY 2015-16, as allowed by the Commission shall be the provisional pooled cost of power purchase for FY 2016-17 till the same is determined by the Commission.

**6. Determination of pooled cost of power purchase for FY 14-15 and FY 15-16 of Jaipur Discom (Petition no. 606/16 and 607/16).**

- (i) Jaipur Vidyut Vitran Nigam Ltd.(JVVNL) filed the petitions for determination of pooled cost of power purchase for FY 2014-15 and for 2015-16 under Regulation 10 (2) (a) of RERC (Renewable Energy Certificate and Renewable Purchase Obligation Compliance Framework) Regulations, 2010 .
- (ii) The matter was heard on 10.03.2016. Considering the data of the Discom and audited accounts placed, Commission vide its order dated 31.03.2016 determined the pooled cost of power purchase for FY 2014-15 and 2015-16 as Rs. 3.5370 and Rs. 3.3987 per unit respectively.
- (iii) The pooled cost of power purchase for FY 2015-16, as allowed by the Commission shall be the provisional pooled cost of power purchase for FY 2016-17 till the same is determined by the Commission.

**7. Determination of pooled cost of power purchase for FY 14-15 and FY 15-16 of Jodhpur Discom (Petition no. 625/16 and 626/16).**

- (i) Jodhpur Vidyut Vitran Nigam Ltd.(AVVNL) filed the petitions for determination of pooled cost of power purchase for FY 2014-15 and for 2015-16 on 11.03.2016, under Regulation 10 (2) (a) of RERC (Renewable Energy Certificate and Renewable Purchase Obligation Compliance Framework) Regulations, 2010.

(ii) The matter was heard on 31.03.2016. As on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2016, matter was under consideration of the Commission.

**8. Approval of Wheeling Charges and Cross Subsidy charges for FY 2015-16 (Petition no. 536/15).**

(i) Discoms filed the petitions for determination of Wheeling Charges and Cross Subsidy Charges, under Section 42 (2) and section 86 of the Electricity Act, 2003 to be read with Regulation 86 of RERC (Terms and Conditions for Determination of Tariff), 2014 and Regulation 14 of RERC (Terms and Conditions for Open Access) Regulations, 2004.

(ii) On 04.02.2016, petitioners requested the Commission to grant time as they desired to file amendments in the petition in view of the new Tariff Policy.

(iii) As on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2016, matter was under consideration of the Commission.

**9. Aggregate Revenue Requirement (ARR) & Provisional Tariff for FY 2013-14(103 days) for Chhabra Thermal Power Plant (CTPP) Unit-3 (1x250 MW) (Petition No. 450/14).**

RVUN filed a petition on 16.04.2014 for determination of ARR & Provisional Tariff for FY 2013-14(103 days) for Chhabra Thermal Power Plant (CTPP) Unit-3. Commission vide its order dated 22.05.2015 provisionally approved the capital cost as on CoD of unit-3 of CTPP as Rs. 1431.31 Crore. Accordingly the Commission approved provisional tariff for FY 2013- 14 for Unit # 3 of CTPP as follows :

**10. ARR & Provisional Tariff for Ramgarh Gas Thermal Power Plant (RGTPP) Stage III (1x110 MW Open Cycle-116days) for FY 2013-14 (Petition No. 451/14).**

RVUN filed a petition on 21.04.14 for determination of ARR & Provisional Tariff for Ramgarh Gas Thermal Power Plant (RGTPP) Stage III (1x110 MW Open Cycle -116days) for FY 2013-14. Commission vide its order dated 17.06.2015 provisionally approved the capital cost as on CoD of Stage III (1x110 MW Open Cycle as Rs. 414.64 Crore. Accordingly, Commission approved the provisional tariff for FY 2013-14 for Stage III (1x1 10 MW GT) as follows :

**11. ARR & Provisional Tariff for Ramgarh Gas Thermal Power Plant (RGTPP) Stage III (1x110 MW Open Cycle 29 days) and (1x160 MW Combined Cycle 336 days) for FY 2014-15(Petition No. 452/14).**

RVUN filed a petition on 14.05.2014 for determination of ARR & Provisional Tariff for Ramgarh Gas Thermal Power Plant (RGTPP) Stage III (1x110 MW Open Cycle 29 days) and (1x160 MW Combined cycle) for FY 2014-15. Commission vide its order dated 18.06.2015 Provisionally Approved the Capital Cost as on COD of RGTPP Stage-III 1X160 MW Combined Cycle as Rs. 684.88 Crore. Accordingly, Commission approved the provisional tariff for FY 2014-15 for RGTPP Stage-III Thermal Power Station as follows :

**12. Determination of ARR & Provisional Tariff for Unit-1(1x600 MW) of Kalisindh Thermal Power Project for FY 2014-15 from COD of Unit-1 to 31.03.2015. (Petition No. 462/14).**

RVUN filed a petition on 19.06.2014 for determination of ARR and Provisional Tariff for FY 2014-15(329 days) for Kalisindh Thermal Power Plant (KaTPP) Unit-1. Commission vide its order dated 14.05.2015 provisionally approved the Capital Cost of KaTPP Unit-1 as on COD as Rs. 4502.07 Crore. Accordingly, the Commission approved the provisional tariff for FY 2014-15 for Unit # 1 of KaTPP as follows :

In the said order, Commission allowed the CT/PT operated meters with '5A' current rating in place of '1A' rating specified in the Regulations for two years and requiring Discoms to make arrangements to use meters, etc. as specified in the Regulations. Commission also allowed connectivity to the eligible consumers connected on 415 V three phase supply and having connected load upto 5 kW.

**2. Petition filed by Discoms for relaxation/amendment in 5% rebate and time period specified in Regulation 31 of RERC (Supply Code and Connected Matters) Regulations, 2004 for replacement of stopped/defective meters (Petition no. 508/15).**

- (i) Discoms have collectively filed petition for relaxation/amendment in 5% rebate and time period specified in Regulation 31 of RERC (Supply Code and Connected Matters) Regulations, 2004 for replacement of stopped/defective meters.
- (ii) The Commission vide its order dt. 09.10.2015 on the matter noted that not replacing the defective meters for more than two months is not in the interest of Discoms as consumers will not pay on the basis of electricity consumed and on the contrary will get additional benefit of 5% rebate and directed to replace all the existing defective meters on war footing and also adhere to the time frame given for replacement of defective meters in the Regulations. It was observed that Discoms may consider replacement of meters/defective meters with AMR (Automatic Meter Reading) system which are now available starting with high value and NDS category of consumers so that reading of meters can be obtained timely and accurately ensuring realization of bills regularly.

**3. Petition for amendment in RERC (Terms and Conditions for Determination of Tariff) Regulations, 2014 under Regulation 96 read with Regulation 95 of Tariff Regulations, 2014 (Petition no. 557/15).**

- (i) Discoms filed petition for amendment in RERC (Terms and Conditions for Determination of Tariff) Regulations, 2014 (in short 'Tariff Regulations, 2014) under Regulation 96 (Power to remove difficulties) read with Regulation 95 (Power to amend) of Tariff Regulations, 2014 submitting that Discoms are facing some difficulties in the the existing Tariff Regulations, that it is not possible to calculate the Voltage wise fixed assets register and losses on each voltage level.
- (ii) Commission vide its order dt. 07.10.2015 held that compliance of Regulation 86 is necessary for calculating the wheeling charges.
- (iii) Thereafter Discoms filed a petition (Petition no. 582/15) for review of Commission order dated 07.10.2015. Considering the submissions made on behalf of the Discoms about the absence of data, etc. for complying the regulations , the Commission vide its order dated 27.01.2016 in exercise of its powers conferred under Regulation 86 (6) granted extension upto the year FY 2015-16 for compliance of Regulation 86.

## **Chapter – VIII : Various Other Activities**

### **State Advisory Committee**

In pursuance of the provisions contained in Section 87 of the Electricity Act, 2003, the Commission has constituted a State Advisory Committee to advise the Commission on:

1. Major questions of policy.
2. Matters relating to quality, continuity and extent of service provided by the Licensee.
3. Compliance by Licensees with the conditions and requirement of their license.
4. Protection of consumer's interest.
5. Electricity supply and overall standards of performance by utilities.

During the year, a meeting of the Advisory Committee was held on 24<sup>th</sup> June, 2015. As the term of the Advisory Committee expired in Jan. 2016, the Commission constituted a new State Advisory Committee vide Order dated 7.1.2016. The list of the Members of the present State Advisory Committee is at Annexure 'C'.

### **2. Standards of Performance of Discoms**

Section 59(2) of the Electricity Act, 2003 stipulates that the Commission is to publish, at least once a year, the level of performance achieved by the Distribution Companies. The Commission has framed the RERC (Standards of Performance for Distribution Licensees) Regulations, 2014 & prescribed the formats for submission of reports half yearly to the Commission. The reports as submitted by the Discoms are placed on the website of the Commission.

### **3. Commission Website**

The website of the Commission is [www.rerc.rajasthan.gov.in](http://www.rerc.rajasthan.gov.in) which is being updated regularly.

### **4. Income and Budgeted expenditure**

The source of income of the Commission is mainly Annual license and petition fees. During the year the income of the Commission from above sources was Rs. 1548.10 lacs. Against this the expenditure for the year is Rs. 736.76 lacs.

The Commission has transferred an amount of Rs. 36.99 lacs out of its revenue, into pension trusts, based on Actuarial Valuation.

### Chapter – IX: Consumer Affairs

#### 1. Consumer Affairs

The following salient features, relating to the Grievance Redressal Mechanism, are in place:-

- (1) In exercise of the power conferred on it under section 42 (5) of the Electricity Act 2003, the Commission has specified the Regulation for Redressal of Consumer Grievances "RERC (Guideline for Redressal of Grievances) Regulation 2008" notified in March 2008. As per provisions of Regulations, the licensee has established Consumer Grievance Redressal Forums at various levels. According to the Regulations a consumer may approach the appropriate level of forum, excluding the cases under section 126 and section 135 of the Act, as per the jurisdiction.



Presently, 701 nos. of CGRFs are working in the State for redressal of grievances. The consolidated position of Redressal of grievance by various CGRFs for the FY 2015-16 (April 15 – March 16) is as under:-

The consumer is free to approach the Electricity Ombudsman, in case grievance is not redressed by the forum within specified time or consumer is not satisfied with the disposal made by CGRF.

2.2 An independent Ombudsman, namely, Electricity Ombudsman started functioning with effect from 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2010, and the status of the grievances, redressed by the Electricity Ombudsman, during the year 2015-16, is as follows:-

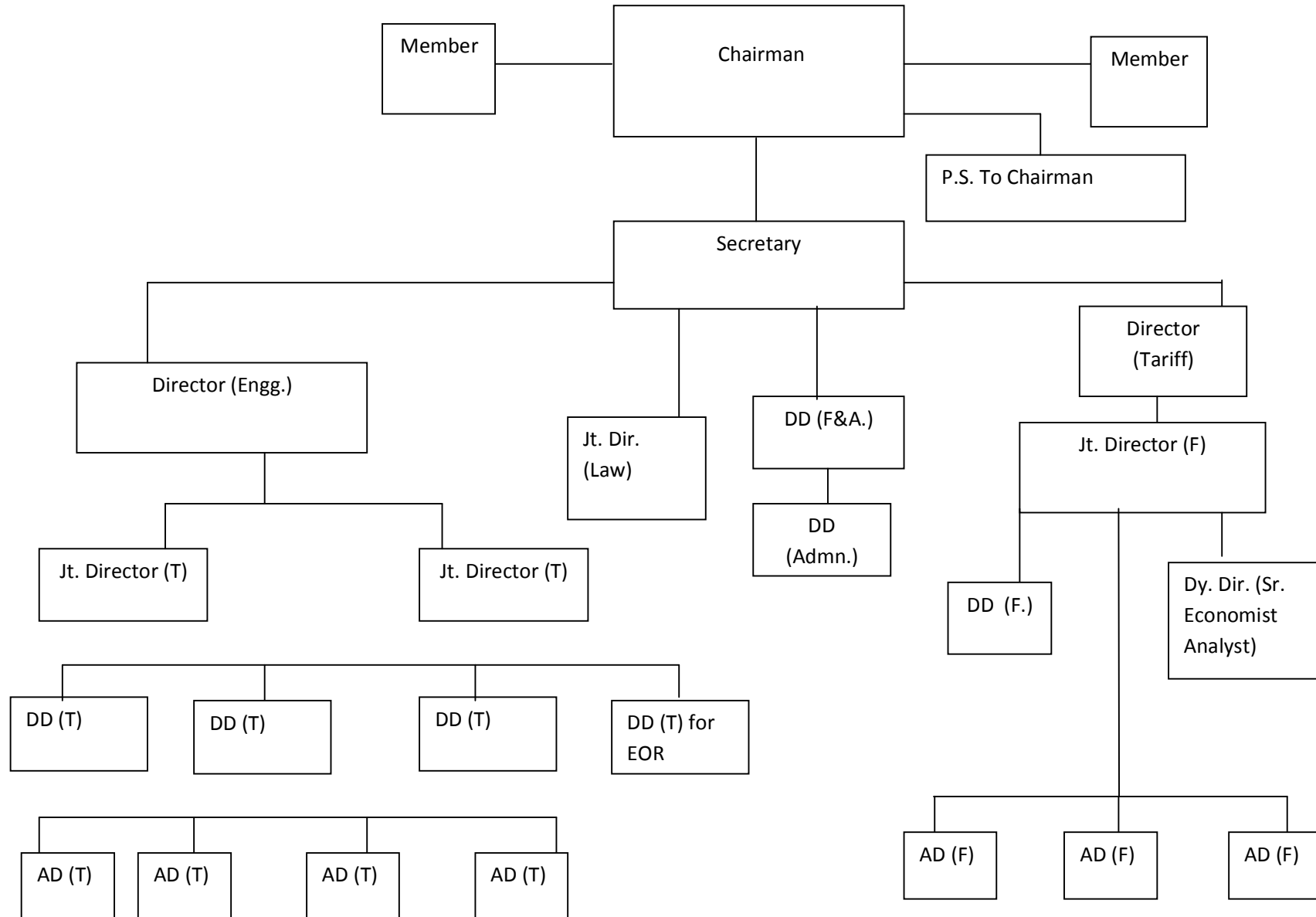
